Danish-US collaboration on innovation and sustainability highlighted at Bella Center

In 2010 the Climate Factory, a unique research and demonstration centre concerning climate and environment developed by Baltic Sea Solutions (Bass) together with Højbygaard Paper Factory in Holeby, will open its doors on the innovative island of Lolland, nationally and internationally proactive in the promotion and implementation of renewable energy sources as a regional growth driver. The Climate Factory will contribute with innovative environment and energy technologies to the dissemination of Lolland's collective climate program. It will be a future information and demonstration centre, which can additionally be used for research and educational purposes. Within this context, integrated global, national and regional models developed by the Millennium Institute and the "Science On a Sphere (SOS)®" technology developed by the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration-NOAA (USA), will play a central role in displaying animated data of environmental processes at various levels (atmospheric, land, oceanic, polar scenarios, etc.) on a two meter diameter sphere with well-crafted, new visualisation techniques.

The SOS has recently arrived in Denmark and has been located at the 200 sqm-US Centre stand in Bella Centre, as an exceptional centrepiece in support of COP 15 discussions. We would be honoured if you could take your time to visit us during the course of the climate conference to experience this powerful technology live and have more information regarding the Climate Factory and the future developments of what will be Denmark's first innovative climate education and research platform for the SOS technology.
